

## Risk Assessment - flag pole making

Hazard	Who might be harmed	Control methods
Moving long pioneering poles	All involved	<p>Scouts should be careful and tell others when moving long pioneering poles</p> <p>Poles should be a suitable weight for Scouts or Explorer Scouts. DO NOT use heavy pioneering poles</p> <p>Be careful of getting fingers caught</p>
Slipping hazards: around area	All involved	<p>Pre-briefing warning participants and helpers of slippery conditions.</p> <p>Adequate, lighting and safety tapes so as Scouts can see where they are allowed.</p> <p>Supervision at all times.</p>
General	All involved	<p>If necessary Scout should be taken back to base.</p>
